_____ Any insurance related to exhibited artwork will be at the expense of the Artist:

_____ Artwork will not be received prior to or held after the exhibition window without prior written consent.

_____ Artwork will arrive display ready at the expense of the Artist. Devices and mechanisms for display will be provided by the City.

_____ Unless specifically approved, artwork that is inappropriate for family audiences will not be allowed, including those containing words or visual depictions which are pornographic, obscene, vulgar, or demeaning to race, religion, creed, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, or age. Minimum standards for display are described under UCA §76-10-1227 – 1228 or other applicable law.

_____ Representative examples of exhibition may be photographed and archived for historic purposes and/or event marketing.

_____ Sale of displayed work will be handled by the Artist. The City, however, may provide general information, including artist contact information and price lists to exhibit patrons.

_____ Marketing or advertising of the exhibit will be the primary responsibility of the Artist. However, the City will promote the exhibit through appropriate websites, social media, and other resources at the City's disposal (such as newsletters, bookmarks, press releases, and the like).

_____ Exhibiting artists will receive no monetary remuneration or compensation without prior written consent. Neither will the City receive remuneration, compensation, or commission for sales generated by the exhibit without prior written consent.

_____ Except as listed above, the City will post notification that photographs or reproductions of the exhibit is prohibited.
