## Agenda Item 1 - Welcome and Greetings

## Agenda Item 2 – Prior Meeting Minutes Approval

## Agenda Item 4 – Action Items

- Transportation Survey
  - An open discussion was held on who completed the Survey and entered points on the map.
- Upcoming Term Renewals
  - Brian would like to continue as Secretary.
  - Jackie will send a notification to other committee members and see if anyone else is nominated.
- New ATC member nominees
  - We have 2 nominees
  - Carter can't come to meetings anymore as he is on another committee
  - Scott makes a motion to submit both nominees to the Mayor, Brian seconds the motion, Mac Urie approved both, Joe Elliott preferred Mark,
  - Unanimously approved plus Mac and Joe.
  - Scott will furnish the nominees to the Mayor.
- ADA Compliance Issues with Sidewalk infrastructure
  - Jamie made a very interesting review of ADA compliance on some of our sidewalk infrastructure
    - Measurement of Driveway cross slopes for ADA compliance
    - 65% of the cross slopes on 300 W were greater than the 2% cross slope allowed by ADA
    - Appears to be a social equity issue N of 200 W
    - Scott suggests we invite City street maintenance to a future meeting so we can discuss getting bike lanes into the city's ongoing street maintenance schedule
- Idling of Vehicles Ordinance Discussion
  - Should city consider adopting an ordinance in line with the University

- Scott will review the draft ordinance that Jamie
- A discussion was held regarding whether the issue should be more of a public information effort as the first step

- Kara can get a \$2 k grant every 6 months from the Health Department for promoting bike safety, bike racks, messaging
