



COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT



You are an extremely important role model for your young players. Sportsmanship is VERY important to our program. Please conduct yourself in a manner that will bring credit to you and your team as well as Cedar City Leisure Services.

1. Coaches shall complete the background screening check before coaching their first practice.
2. Coaches shall conduct themselves in the highest degree always, led by example and demonstrate good sportsmanship, fair play and teach integrity of the game.
3. Coaches shall avoid the use of alcohol, drugs and tobacco products at practices or at game sites.
4. Coaches shall respect and support contest officials. The coach shall not indulge in conduct which would incite players, parents or spectators against the officials.
5. Coaches shall refrain from obscene or demeaning language, it will not be tolerated and using such language or becoming enraged or yelling, will be required to that the coach leave the facility and may be terminated from coaching responsibilities
6. Coaches should ensure the kids have a positive experience. All players are deserving of equal opportunities including providing at least one-half game time to each player.
7. Coaches shall refrain from fighting, doing so will result in suspension for one year.
8. Coaches shall encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game and practice.
9. Coaches shall will refrain from running up the score.
10. Coaches shall will place the developmental, emotional and physical well-being of each player ahead of any personal desire to win.
11. Coaches shall understand that the berating of officials, coaches and players is not acceptable. Complaining about calls and a whining attitude has no place in youth sport.
12. I agree that by not fulfilling any portion of my Coaching Responsibilities as outlined, I will forfeit my right to coach.
